



JOIN US FOR JUNIOR SCIENTIST AND EXPLORER CAMP GPC Summer Camp Program 2018

Session I* (June 25th - July 6th): Paleontologist Training

Children will have the chance to become mini paleontologists! We will make and excavate fossils, play dinosaur themed games, and create different dinosaur themed art projects. Children will learn about what it means to be a paleontologist while engaging in different dinosaur themed activities.

Session II (July 9th - July 20th): Around the World Exploration

Get your passports ready! We will be traveling to a different country each day. Children will have the opportunity to explore different cultures and traditions from around the world through cooking, music, dance and art activities.

Session III (July 23rd - August 3rd): Meteorologist Training

Children will become mini meteorologists and learn all about the weather! They will participate in exciting experiments and art projects both indoors and outdoors. Children will make rain clouds with shaving cream/sponges, conduct hot air-cold air experiments, create rainbow art projects, make a hurricane/tornado in a bottle, use binoculars for cloud watching, make a wind blow painting, and build a windsock kite, among many other fun activities. We will read stories and poems, sing songs, and play games that all relate to our meteorologist training.

Session IV (August 6th - August 17th): Water Works and Oceanography

This session will include water experiments involving floating, sinking and absorption. Children will participate in a floating and sinking game, have a beach party, and work on ocean themed art projects. We will study the ocean and learn about the different organisms and creatures that live there, e.g. sharks, crabs, fish, and dolphins. Children will get to play games such as sharks and minnows, crab races, and an outdoor fishing game.
